

BYLAW NO. 07-2011

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR FIRE  
PROTECTIVE SERVICES COST RECOVERY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
  - a)“Administrator” shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
  - b)“Council” shall mean the council of the municipality; and
  - c)“Municipality” shall mean the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160.
  - d)“Fire Response” shall mean any response by:
    - i) The Village of Pense and the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160 Volunteer Fire Department (PVFD) and/or
    - ii) The Moose Jaw Fire Department (MJFD) for protection of person(s) and/or property.
2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with the following:
  - a) Pense Volunteer Fire Department - \$350.00/hour;
  - b) Moose Jaw Fire Department – Schedule A fee: \$500.00 plus Schedule B fee: per individual MJFD invoice.
  - c) The cost of chemicals and other extinguishing agents, excluding water, used to extinguish or prevent and/or limit the spread of fire.
  - d) The fees in a) and b) shall be reduced by the amount of \$400 for ratepayers of the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160 with the exception of unreported controlled burns.
3. The fees mentioned in Section 2. shall be payable directly to the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160.
4. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year.
5. Bylaw No. 7-00 is hereby repealed.
