

BYLAW NO. 2020-07

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions: For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) “firearm” shall mean a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows or any other thing.
2. No person shall discharge any firearm within this municipality.
3. In additions to Section (2), no person shall discharge any firearm within the municipality except:
 - a) by a person on land which he or she owns, leases or rents, or a member of his or her family or any other person with his or her permission on the said land;
or
 - b) by a person, who during open hunting season, holds a license to hunt wildlife as defined under *The Wildlife Act*, issued to him or her under *The Wildlife Act*, with permission of the landowner; or
 - c) where Council has issued a permit to a recognized gun club or similar organization.
4. This bylaw does not apply to a person having the authority under a statute of Canada or Saskatchewan to have in his possession a firearm when such firearm is discharged under the authority of his or her duty and within the scope of his or her duty.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
6. Bylaw No. 2-1966 is hereby repealed.
