BYLAW NO. 2020-07

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Definitions: For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "firearm" shall mean a pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any other device or mechanism capable of firing or propelling bullets, pellets, darts, arrows or any other thing.
- 2. No person shall discharge any firearm within this municipality.
- 3. In additions to Section (2), no person shall discharge any firearm within the municipality except:
 - a) by a person on land which he or she owns, leases or rents, or a member of his or her family or any other person with his or her permission on the said land; or
 - b) by a person, who during open hunting season, holds a license to hunt wildlife as defined under *The Wildlife Act*, issued to him or her under *The Wildlife Act*, with permission of the landowner; or
 - c) where Council has issued a permit to a recognized gun club or similar organization.
- 4. This bylaw does not apply to a person having the authority under a statute of Canada or Saskatchewan to have in his possession a firearm when such firearm is discharged under the authority of his or her duty and within the scope of his or her duty.
- 5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
- 6. Bylaw No. 2-1966 is hereby repealed.
