

BYLAW NO. 2023-03

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PENSE NO. 160
TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTROL AND DESTRUCTION OF
GRASSHOPPERS ON LAND WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

In this bylaw:

- a) “Committee” means members appointed by the Municipality.
 - b) “Council” means the reeve and councillors of the municipality elected pursuant to the provisions of *The Local Government Election Act*.
 - c) “Councillor” means the council member duly elected in the municipality as a councillor, in accordance with *The Local Government Election Act, 2015*.
 - d) “Municipality” means the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160.
 - e) “Owner” means every person who owns, occupies or controls land within the Municipality.
2. The Council shall appoint a committee to be known as the “Grasshopper Control Committee” to administer this Bylaw.
3. Every owner shall take the following measures for the control and destruction of grasshoppers:
- a) be responsible for the application of chemicals on their land, that is, in their opinion and/or in the opinion of the committee, warrants such application; and
 - b) be responsible for the application of chemicals within the area lying between the centre line of the road allowance adjoining their land and the nearest boundary of the said land, that is, in their opinion and/or in the opinion of the committee, warrants such application.
4. If the owner fails to spray and control the grasshoppers on their land, and on the recommendation of the committee, the municipality will spray the infested area and all costs will be charged against the said property.
5. The owner shall bear the costs and the responsibility of obtaining all chemicals and supplies needed to control grasshoppers under this Bylaw.
6. This Bylaw remains in force until repealed by Bylaw of the Municipality.
