

BYLAW NO. 01-2010

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR
DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATIONS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Pense No. 160, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. To cover the costs of processing development permits (application, review, advertisement and issuance), an applicant for a development permit shall pay an application fee in accordance with the following:
 - a) Residential or Agricultural development - \$75.00.
 - b) Commercial or Industrial development
 - i. \$150.00 for a value of development up to \$350,000;
 - ii. \$600.00 for a value of development over \$350,000.
 - c) Development Appeal Fee - up to \$50.00 as specified by the Municipality's Development Appeals Board.

These fees shall be in addition to any public advertisement, administration or consulting fees incurred by the municipality.

2. The Development Officer of the municipality is granted flexibility to charge lower fees than expressed in 1. b) ii. due to minimal time required to process the application.
